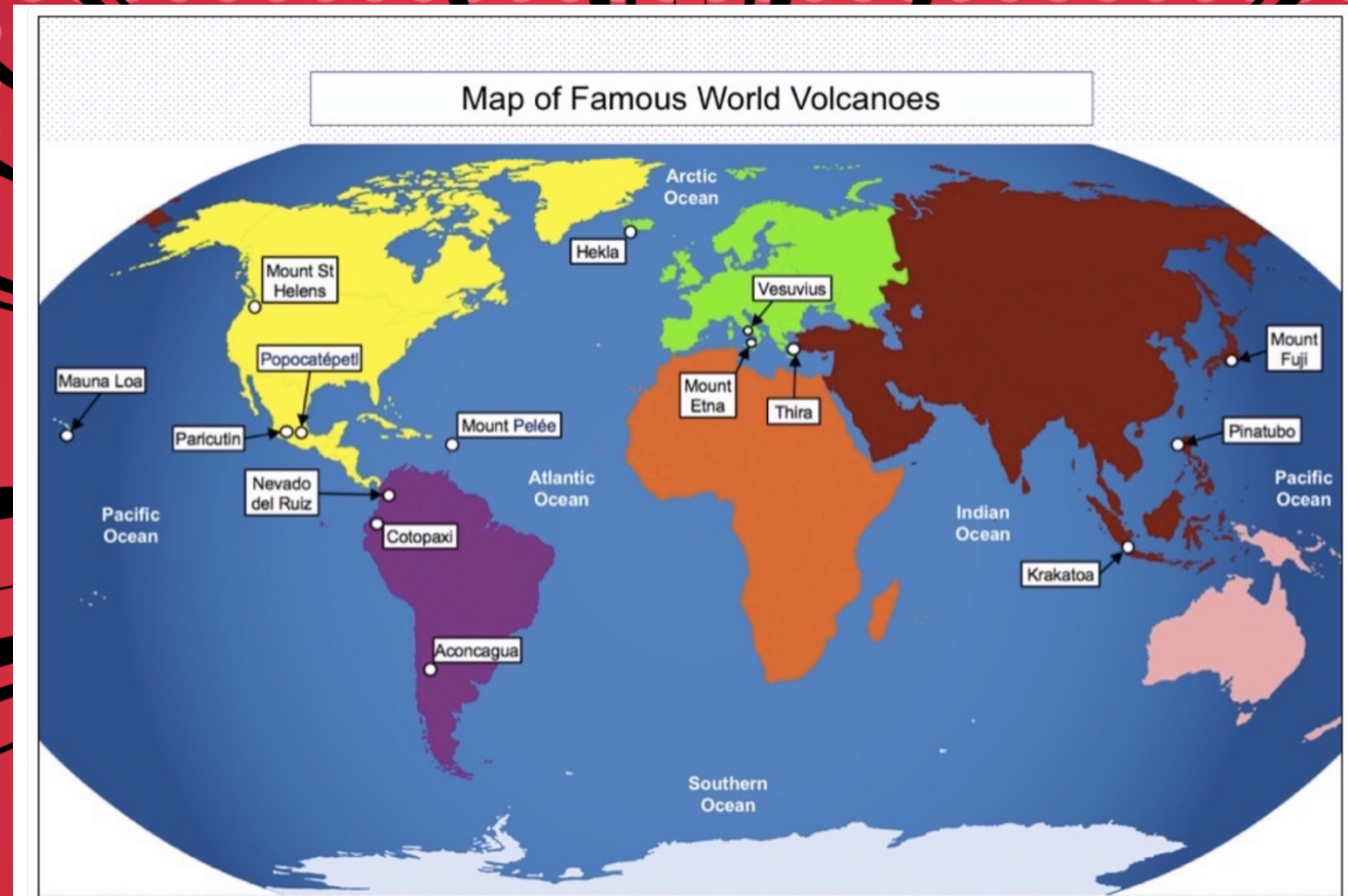
Welcome to my book all about volcanoes.

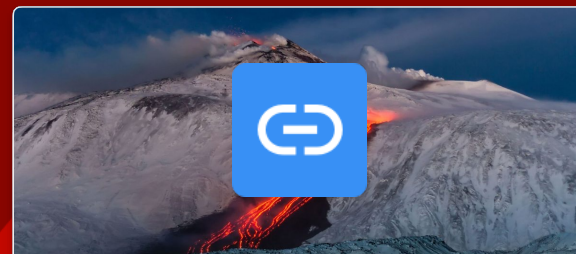
