School Uniform Reminder

As part of our ongoing focus on our school core values — **Ambition, Courage, Respect, Love, Hope and Faith** — we are placing a renewed emphasis on **respect**, particularly through pride in our school environment and personal appearance.

Wearing the correct school uniform helps to reduce distractions, promotes a sense of belonging, and ensures all children feel part of the **RAMJS family**. We have noticed a small number of uniform exceptions recently and would greatly appreciate your support in ensuring children come to school dressed in line with our uniform expectations.

School Uniform

Our uniform consists of:

- Red jumper
- White polo shirt, shirt or blouse
- Black or grey trousers, shorts, skirt or culottes
- Red and white checked summer dress
- Black school shoes or **all-black trainers only** (*no coloured trainers, please*)
- Black, white or grey socks / black or grey tights

What Children Should Bring Each Day

- Coat
- Book bag
- Water bottle
- Packed lunch (if applicable)

All these items should be taken home daily.

Jewellery, Makeup and Hair

- Jewellery should not be worn unless for religious reasons
- Plain stud earrings only, which must be removed on P.E. Days—**Hoops and large earrings are not allowed**
- Hair styles should be sensible and appropriate for school
- Hair accessories should be in keeping with school uniform colours
- Make up and acrylic nails should not be being worn by children in school

P.E. Kit

- T-shirt
- Joggers or shorts
- Pumps or **all-black trainers**
- School jumper

P.E. kits may remain in school during the term and should be taken home regularly for washing. Year 5 and Year 6 can come in their P.E. kits.

Outdoor Learning

On Outdoor Learning days, children should come dressed in warm, practical clothing suitable for outdoor activities that may get muddy. Wellies and a waterproof coat are highly recommended, particularly during colder months. Further information will be shared by **Mr Moran and Mrs Langfield** when needed.

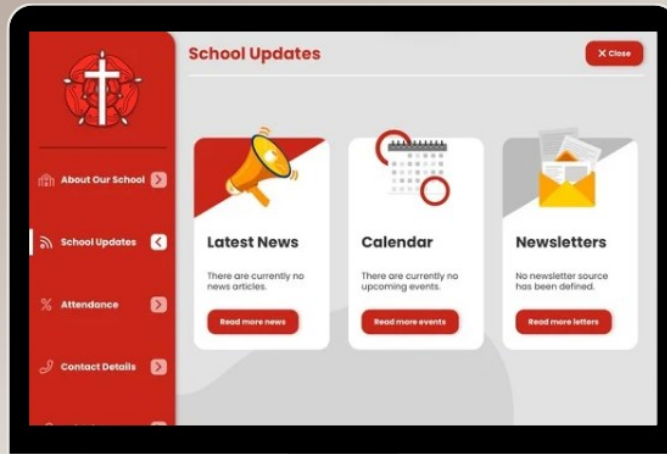
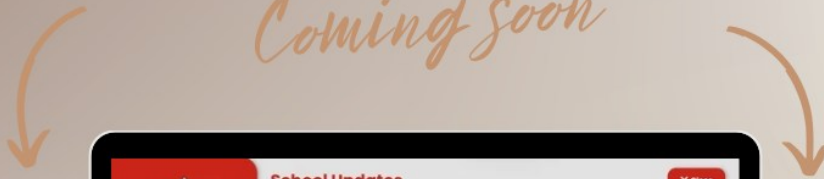
