Please can we ask if parents who are accessing the playground from the Infant side at home time, do not enter the playground until 3:15pm which is when our main gates are opened by a staff member. This is a safeguarding matter as there are no staff on the playground until 3:15pm and there may be junior children still participating in lessons.

Can we also ask that if you have Infant children and toddlers that you supervise them fully and keep them with you at all times as it has been noticed that they have been running around the playground, climbing on equipment which is not safe if unsupervised and may break.

School Meals

Dear Parent/Carers

As you are aware, if you pay for your child to have a school dinner the cost is £2.90 per day (£14.50 per week). Please ensure there are sufficient funds on your child's ParentPay account before your child orders their lunch.

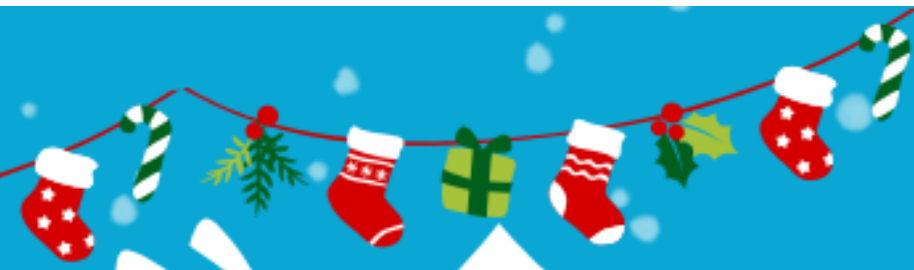
Unfortunately, we are seeing an increase in Parents not paying in advance meaning they are accumulating monies owed to school which is resulting in school having to cover the costs and staff having to repeatedly contact/chase parents.

We suggest that if your child has a school dinner every day, that you top up their ParentPay account each weekend or every Monday morning before your child arrives at school with enough money to cover the week. If you prefer to put money on for the month ahead this can also be done. If your child does not have sufficient funds in their account, you will be required to provide them with a packed lunch.
