### P.E.

From 13th April 2026 it is a non-negotiable expectation that all children are wearing a P.E. kit for P.E. as it is part of the P.E. curriculum and National Curriculum expectations that children wear this kit as part of their lesson.

Due to Y5 and Y6 having ICT and P.E. on the same afternoon, pupils in **Year 5 and Year 6** will be asked to come to school **already dressed in their P.E. kits** on their allocated P.E. day. This helps us maximise active learning time and supports pupils in being organised and ready for their lessons.

To keep pupils looking smart and to support good habits as they prepare for high school, we ask that all children wear the **correct school P.E. kit**, which is:

**Black shorts or black joggers/leggings**

**White T-shirt**

**Black trainers**

**Red school jumper** (may be worn with P.E. kit)

**Y6 pupils may wear their leavers' hoodies**

Please note that **non-school P.E. items**, including football shirts, fashion wear, brightly coloured hoodies or branded sportswear, should not be worn. If children arrive in clothing that does not meet the school's expectations, we will contact parents to ensure this can be corrected.

This approach not only maintains high standards of presentation but also supports pupils' transition to high school, where similar expectations are in place.

### Outdoor Education

All children will continue to wear their own clothes for outdoor learning. As with P.E., this should not include fashion wear, football shirts or expensive clothing items. We want children to be able to thrive outdoors, feel comfortable taking part and be appropriately dressed as part of our Health and Safety expectations.

# Exciting News from Our Young Choir!

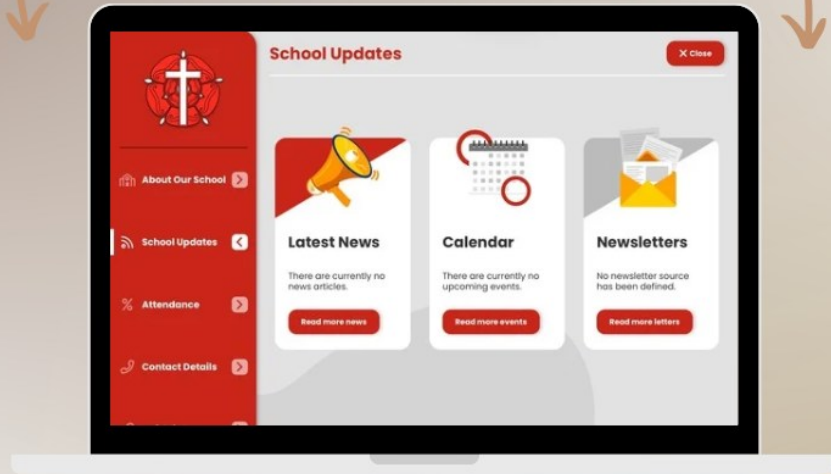
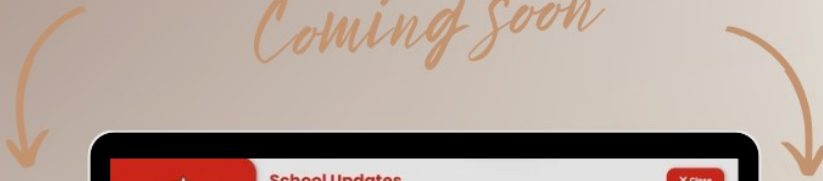
