I hope you have all enjoyed a wonderful week and are looking forward to the week ahead.

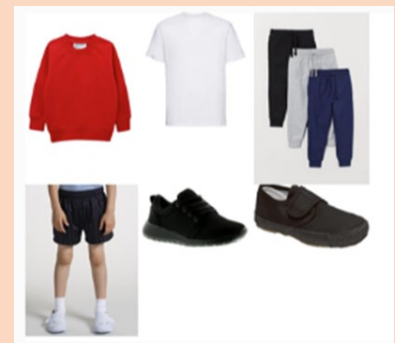
I have observed that despite regular reminders, we are still seeing a large number of children not bringing their P.E. Kits into school. This is a school expectation and something that we need parent support to combat.
