Ask your child's class teacher or Mrs Child/Miss France if you would like to share a story in class or in a small group during World Book Week.

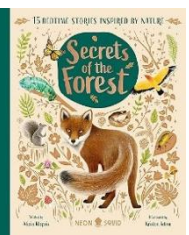
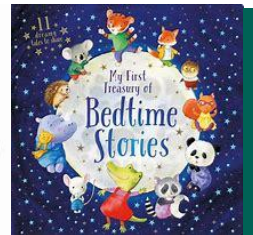
Reading Glow Up – optional items to bring

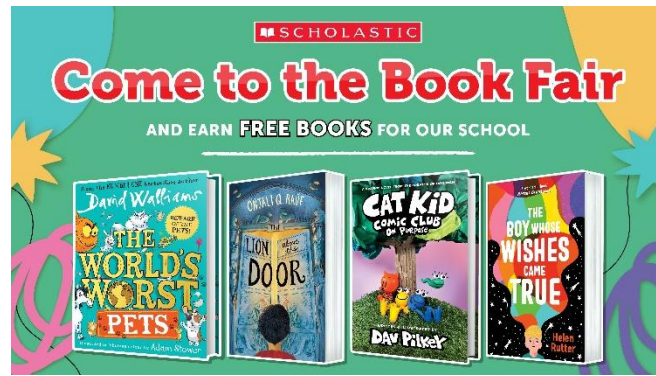
Design a book voucher National Book Token Competition (template provided) and return to school. You could win books for yourself and for school.
